- Where did the story take place (setting)?
- Tell me what happened at the beginning of the story? In the middle? At the end?
- How are Little Loon and his parents alike? How are they different?

- Complete the problem and solution page. Next, have your child write or draw and label the problem and solution for each set of pages listed.

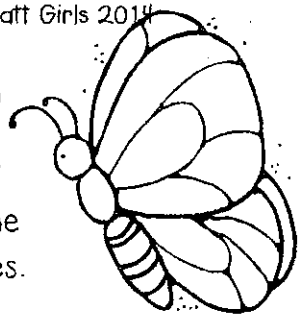
***Math**

_____ Play the board game, "Disney Addition/Subtraction": Students can use counters (pennies, cereal pieces, small toys, etc...) to help them solve the math facts.

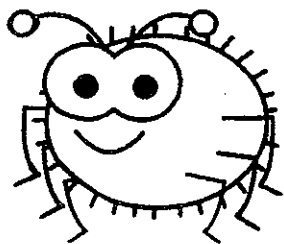
1. Players each place their piece on start.

5. The first player to the end of the board wins.

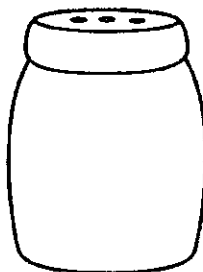
